Location: Conveniently situated in downtown Saginaw at Johnson & North Washington Streets, adjacent to the Temple Theatre and near the Dow Event Center.

Parking: Supervised lot available for members. Overflow parking is available across the street. Guests may use the lot when attending member-sponsored events.

Entrances: Members may enter through the front, side, or rear entrances using a key card. Office staff can assist if a card is unavailable.

- Member's Bar: Mon–Sat, 4 pm – close (alcohol service ends 2 am).
